MASTERPIECES FROM THE BORGHESE GALLERY

6 SEPTEMBER 2024 - 5 JANUARY 2025

For the reopening exhibition, around 40 masterpieces from the Borghese Gallery in Rome will be on display. The foundation of this famous collection was laid by Cardinal Scipione Borghese (1577-1633), an admirer of Renaissance painters and patron of many artists of his time including Caravaggio, Bernini, and Rubens, Nearly 400 years later, the Borghese Gallery remains a symbol of the economic and cultural prosperity of the Eternal City during the 16th and 17th centuries.



ARTEMISIA GENTILESCHI

14 FEBRUARY - 29 JUNE 2025

Artemisia Gentileschi (1593-c. 1656) was one of the few women artists of the modern era to live off her paintings, thanks to her international success. She was a prominent figure in Caravaggesque painting and was particularly celebrated for her portrayals of heroines and her portrait work. This exhibition revisits Artemisia's work alongside paintings by artists close to her, such as her father Orazio and the French painter Simon Vouet.
